20 Mile per Hour Zone

Councillors voted to apply to join the 20mph zone scheme being offered by Oxfordshire County Council. Cllr Brown wished to have it noted that he was not happy with this decision.

Discussion with MOPs included: could the parish look into VAS devices such as the happy/sad faces, can police do spot speed checks, farm traffic is fast, the parish has barely any pavements.

Pond adjacent The Nut Tree

Notice from the owners of the Nut Tree that they are investigating possible ownership of the pond adjacent to the property. The pond deeds are in the name of Cherwell District Council, CDC have approved the registering of interest in claiming the land, but advised that the Parish Council should be consulted. Discussion with Councillors and MOPs. Nut Tree Owners currently maintain the pond and installed a fence to prevent accidents. However due to a large tree being removed nearby, the influx of light has affected the vegetation and now it requires a high level of maintenance and management. Questions included: would the pond be listed if it is included within the curtilage of an existing listed building; could there be a protective covenant for public access/protection of the amenity value; should tree preservation orders be considered on other large trees in the parish;

There is an opportunity to comment online on the request.

Parish Council resolved to work with the Nut Tree Owners, clerk to provide historical information and help.
